What?	SHER 601 - Leading for Change in Early Childhood Education A three-credit, cohort-based graduate course taught by highly experienced faculty and thought leaders. Participants will build skills, knowledge, and dispositions in seven core leadership competencies: -Visioning -Values -People management -Organizational capacity -Results and outcomes -Creativity and innovation -Policy advocacy	SHER 602 - Policy and Advocacy in Early Childhood Education A three-credit, cohort-based graduate course that features an emphasis on building participants' capacity to act as advocates, leaders, and innovators for high-quality practices and research informed policies in early childhood education at the local, state, and national levels.  Students completing SHER 601 and SHER 602 will receive UMBC's Endorsement in Early Childhood Leadership.
